Guidelines for filming in the V&A

- All members of the crew must be supervised by a member of the press office at all times and must act as advised by the press office representative.
- If there is to be more than one camera or a large crew (more than 4 people) the press office must be notified in advance to arrange appropriate supervision.
- Only trained technical service managers can touch or move objects in the Museum. Anything that needs to be moved must be arranged at least a week in advance.
- Tripod legs must be folded up when moving around the Museum to avoid damaging objects.
- Additional cabling, lighting, tracks or other large equipment will not be allowed in the Museum during opening hours and must be agreed in advance with the press office.
- All equipment brought into the Museum is the responsibility of the crew and must not be left unattended. Equipment should either be checked into the cloakroom or kept with the crew at all times.
- No food or drink is allowed in the Galleries. If you need to stop for refreshments you must make alternative arrangements.
