PIKEMAN'S HELMET, about 1620,
and **ARMOUR (BREASTPLATE)**, 1620–40, Room 56d
'The armour is oval shaped with lots of grey and circle studs all over.'



LEOPARD FIGURE, 1884, Room 56e
'I chose the lion. He is gold. His shield is complicated, it is big.'



DACRE BULL, 1507–25, Stairs from Room 48a to Room 57
'I like the crown on his neck. He has a smiley face.'



DACRE DOLPHIN, 1507–25,
Stairs from Room 48a to Room 57
'The fish also has a crown but it is on his head.'



ARMOUR DESIGN, about 1585, Room 57
(next to suit of armour)
'This is the knight and his sword.'



STAINED GLASS PANEL, about 1577, Room 58d
'The window looks bright with the light behind it.
It has three bells.'
