

## Birthday Party Activities

We suggest starting the activity at either 10.30 or 15.00 giving your guests 30 mins to arrive and settle.

### Toddler Activity (60 minutes)

#### **Big Roar** (age 3)

Children make their own dinosaur mask and puppet and take part in an interactive story in the party room...ROOOAAAR!

### Activities (90 minutes)

All activities include arts and crafts, a trail in the museum and party games. If you would like a different order of events please speak to your Activity Assistant on the day.

#### **Animal Detectives** (age 4 - 5)

Partygoers turn detective, make their own badges and animal disguises before searching for missing animals in the museum.

#### **Pirates & Princesses** (age 4 - 7)

In this tale of make believe, party guests must save the princesses from the pirates! Children make pirate hats, crowns and pet parrots then embark on an adventure to rescue the damsels in distress in the museum galleries.

#### **Mad Hatter** (age 5 - 7)

Help the Mad Hatter throw the happiest unbirthday birthday tea party. Transformed into Cheshire cats, partygoers head into the galleries to find the tea party guests and for a game of flamingo croquet.

#### **Super Heroes** (age 5 - 7)

Mini super heroes get suited up to look the part before being put through their paces at super hero training camp. Will they manage to find all the kidnapped toys on their mission around the museum galleries?
