## Make Your Own Robot

### Inspired by the collection

This activity was inspired by this clockwork robot. It was made in Hong Kong in the 1970s.



### You will need:

- Paper or thin card (from recycling)
- Scissors
- Pencil or pen
- Glue or tape
- Colouring pens (optional)
- Kitchen foil (optional)

### Step 1:

Draw and cut out your robot's head, arms, and legs.



### Step 2:

Decorate your robot. You could add a face, buttons, patterns, colours or foil.



### Step 3:

Stick your robot's arms and legs together with clear tape or glue.



### Step 4:

Find some different objects around your home that you could use to make the robot's body.
