Let's make our own colour palette inspired by the colours of autumn.

You will need:

- Natural objects (flowers, leaves etc.)
- Paint & brushes, or colour pencils
- Paper

Remember to wash or sanitise your hands after collecting your natural objects.

Only collect natural objects that have fallen onto the floor. We don't pick things from the plants!

1. Collect natural objects from your local park or garden. Try to pick a range of different colours.

2. Using paint or colour pencils, mix colours to imitate shades or tones you find in the natural objects. Try being very specific.





3. Make a new painting using the colours you have made.



What will you paint with your original autumn colour palette?
