

Crafting with natural materials

See how makers and designers have used natural found objects and turned them into something completely different.

You will need:

- Natural objects (pinecones, acorns, twigs, leaves etc.)
- Glue, tape or blu-tack
- Paper
- Colour pencils
- Scissors

Remember to wash or sanitise your hands after collecting your natural objects.

Only collect natural objects that have fallen onto the floor. We don't pick things from the plants!

1. To make a pinecone owl, draw its eyes, wings and beak on a piece of paper and cut them out.



2. Stick the shapes onto the pinecone.
